
An article was published in Elsevier by a group of final year students under the supervision and project administration of Dr. D, K, Singh, Assistant Professor.

ARTICLE: FIRE RETARDING COMPOSITE BOARD

The paper is directed towards the development of fire retarding composite board for fire compartmentation application using waste denim The paper represents a comprehensive review work to understand the utter need to recycle denim waste and its use as a structural member with good mechanical and fire retardant properties for compartmentation under Passive Fire Protection systems. The paper provides the direction towards development of such boards which will not just help in denim waste management but also provide important component of passive fire protection for much needed building fire safety.

PROJECT: GSM BASED DETECTION SYSTEM

A group of Third year BE students have prepared a prototype of GSM based Fire Detection system Arduino (uno) using software. The system employs modern technologies to detect fire and give alarm. On detection of fires through three sensors, this scaled down system alerts with a siren and activates an automatic shutdown mechanism. The alarm system can send alerts to remote locations on cell phones where human interaction is limited such as mines, dense forests, toxic environment, etc. The three sensors detects flame, smoke and elevated temperature and reduces false alarms.



Industrial Visit to IOCL Chandrapur Depot


INDUSTRIAL VISIT:

A group of third year BE students went on an industrial visit to IOCL TADALI Depot near Chandrapur, Maharashtra under the guidance of Shri Gagan Upadhyay, Asst. Director, NFSC to observe and study fire protection systems installed in a vertical floating roof tank with a rim seal protection system.


The depot having storage facilities for Kerosene, Motor Spirit and Diesel has fire protection systems such as Rim Seal Protection for Floating Roof, High Velocity Long Range Monitors, Fire Pump House. The visit enriched the practical experience of the BE students who have been working on a project to design a training module for the fire protection system in a vertical floating roof tank.
