Conduct inspection and surveying the various occupancies as per the NBC 2016 Part IV. 7. Evaluate the compliance of the various occupancies with respect to NBC 2016 Part IV. 8. Act as trainer to create awareness and capacity building.

Age Limit: No age limit Participant must have basic understanding of Hindi and English Language. Medical and Physical Fitness: The participant shall be in good medical and physical condition to perform practical training onsite/off-site. To that effect they must produce the medical fitness certificate from recognized medical practitioner at the time of joining the course.
