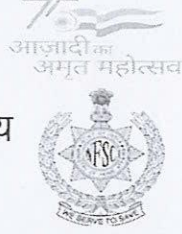



Annual Report 2024-25

National Fire Service College, Nagpur

1. Introduction:

The National Fire Service College (NFSC) was established in 1956 with a core objective to impart education and training to fire professionals of the country in advanced techniques of fire science, fire prevention & protection, fire fighting & rescue techniques, medical support and emergency management and to create uniformity in the fire service organizations and their management across the country.

Besides, the college also runs four year degree course in B. Tech. (Fire Engineering) approved by All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), affiliated to the RTM Nagpur University to create young fire engineers. The purpose of fire service education and training is to ensure that an effective and efficient service possible is provided to the community.

To achieve desired outcome, a unique facilities are being created at 43 acres of land, enabling to replicate various emergency scenarios. The training is reinforced with an application of latest fire fighting equipment & appliances and scientific techniques. The College has its own state of the art thirteen laboratories having cut section of various fire engineering equipment and Fire Protection Lab installing sprinklers, water mist technology, carbon dioxide flooding etc. and many more.

In order to provide the highest level of service to the community, it is prudent that must be imparted that consistently maintains and enhances the knowledge, skills and abilities of fire service responders thus helping in reducing loss of life and minimizing destruction to property due to large scale uncontrolled fires thereby participating in progress of nation.

2. The year 2024:

During the period the college conducted Academic, Training and Short Term Courses for the young aspirants in B. Tech. (Fire) and fire service officers from various Central/ States/ UTs etc. The details are as follows:

5. World's Environment Day 05th June, 2024.

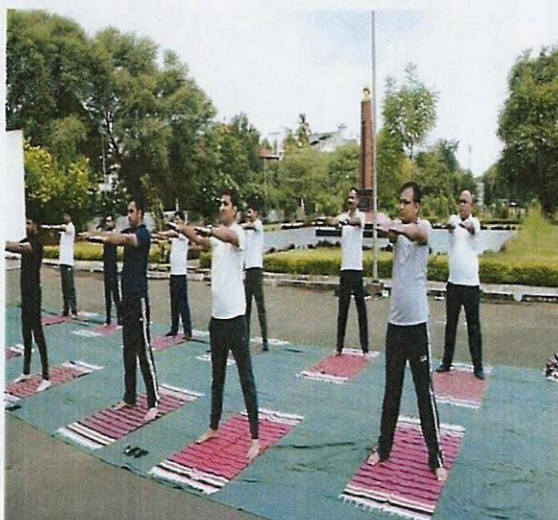
