

NFSC Soon To be Deemed Univ

NFSC has applied for deemed university status to gain academic autonomy and introduce specialised programmes, said Director Nagesh Shingane. Currently affiliated with Nagpur University, the college follows a five-semester syllabus by the Board of Studies. "We are planning an overhaul of our curriculum, expanding infrastructure, increasing student intake, and launching new courses," he said.

A specialised course for forest officers to address the increasing incidence of forest fires. "Designed in consultation with the National Disaster Management Authority, the course will focus on early containment and primary response strategies," Shingane said.

The fire safety drill for hospitals is scheduled for April 28, while the training date for forest officials will be announced soon.

NFSC has also planned a workshop for teachers and inspectors from Nagpur. "The workshop will help prepare school action plans for dealing with natural disasters and fire incidents. Regular drills and safety education will be part of the initiative to foster self-sustaining resilience among students," Shingane said.
